Drunken duo diverted

You were just starting to eat your steak dinner at Heavy Bear's Beef and Brew Bistro, over in Clifton Springs, when the Dunston brothers come staggering down the street, and one of them tried to shoot the oil lamp over your table for target practice... through your window! The burning oil hit your table and you have to act fast, both to save your steak from bein' overcooked and to stop these ne'er-do-well ruffians before they kill somebody.

Ammo

5 pistol (10 for two-pistol shooters), 10 rifle, 4 shotgun

Starting Position

Standing at window, safely holstered pistol(s) loaded with five rounds (each).

Rifle and shotgun safely staged.

Procedure

When ready, shooter says, "*Drunken Dunstons dirtied my dinner!*"

At the buzzer, engage each pistol target in the order of 1, 2, 3, 2, 1. Two-pistol shooters, repeat.

Move to rifle, engage each rifle target in the order of 1, 1, 2, 3, 3, 2, 1, 1, 2, 3. Make rifle safe,

Move to shotgun and engage shotgun targets in the order of 1, 2, 1, 2.

Make shotgun safe.

Timer stops.

Props

Window wall, chair

Targets

3 rifle, 3 pistol, 2 shotgun



Pharmaceutical fiends foiled!

Over at Ms. Pennywurth's Pumice Rubs and Other Remedies, Ms. Pennywurth has whipped up a medicated patch for the burn you received puttin' out your burnin' steak dinner the dastardly Dunston brothers started. But wait, the guy applying the poultice is not one of Ms. Pennywurth's employees. It's the other Dunston brother, come to finish you off! Better get out fast!

Ammo

5 Pistol (10 for two gun shooters), 10 Rifle, 4 Shotgun

Starting Position

Standing at table, with safely holstered pistol(s)

Rifle and shotgun safely staged.

Pocket Pistol/Derringer staged on table.

Procedure

When ready, yell "*Ms. Pennywurth, this poultice is positively powerless!*"

At the buzzer, engage rifle targets in the order of 1-1-2-3-4-4-3-2-1-1. Make rifle safe.

Engage pistol targets in a continuous sweep; 1-2-3-4-5. Two gun shooters shoot second gun in reverse. Holster pistol.

Engage shotgun targets 1-2-3-4.

Make shotgun safe.

Engage Pocket Pistol/Derringer target. Make Pocket Pistol/Derringer safe.

Timer stops.

5 pistol, 4 rifle, 4 shotgun, Derringer/Pocket Pistol



Misunderstandings make for mischief!

You've met up with your friend Horace Hangerfield for a few drinks at the American Hotel, in Lima, to nurse your wound and wash that foul taste of steak and kerosene out of your mouth. After a few rounds of whiskey, Horace decides to show you his brand-spanking new Smith and Wesson Schofield, which he forgets is loaded, and, after drawing it, he accidentally discharges a round into the floor. The shot makes a group of low-lying patrons think Horace was taking a shot at them, and they're drawing their guns!

"It's My Turn Horace!!"

Ammo

4 Pocket Pistol or 2 Derringer, 5 Pistol (10 for two gun shooters), 10 Rifle, 4 Shotgun

Starting Position

Standing next to barrel with safely holstered pistol(s),

Pocket Pistol/Derringer safely staged on barrel.

Rifle safely staged

Shotgun safely staged.

Procedure

When ready, yell ***"Holy, Horace! Guess Happy Hour's over!"***

At the buzzer, engage pistol targets in the following order 1-5-2-4-3. Two gun shooters, repeat order.

Make pistols safe and engage rifle targets in an Outside/Inside Sweep in the following order:

1-1-1-3-3-3-2-2-2-2

Make rifle safe.

Engage shotgun targets 1-2-1-2.

Make shotgun safe.

Engage Pocket Pistol/Derringer target. Make Pocket Pistol/Derringer safe.

Time stops.

Bar-Fight Busts out on beman street!

You decide it's time to go home. On your way through Canandaigua, you walk by the Farmer's Inn, and a fight spills out into the street. Somebody throws a punch at you... and misses. Then the shootin' starts. You are forced to defend yourself. But, watch your aim- there are bystanders out there that need to be kept alive to testify that it was self-defense on your part!

Ammo

5 Pistol (10 for two gun shooters), 4 shotgun, 10 rifle

Starting Position

Standing behind rock at firing line with safely holstered pistol(s).

Procedure

When ready, shooter says ***"Stop shootin', shameless citizens!"***

At the buzzer, engage pistol targets 1-5-2-4-3. Two gun shooters shoot same with second gun.

The shooter moves to shotgun and engages two shotgun targets; 1, 2, 1, 2.

The shooter retrieves rifle and engages the three rifle targets, sweeping left to right three times (1, 2, 3, 2, 1, 2, 3, 2, 1, 1).

Upon completion, shooter places his open and empty shotgun in the rack.

Time stops.

Wayward Pests Put Down

Back in Shortsville, you see critters just waiting to be added to the Easter dinner table. Sounds like a “Dinner Date”. Pass the corn!

Ammo

10 Rifle, 5 pistol (10, for two-gun shooters), 10 Rifle caliber rifle, or 10 .22 caliber rifle

Starting Position

Standing with safely holstered pistol(s),
Rifle safely held at Cowboy Port Arms, or
Shooter in position with single-shot rifle

Procedure

At the buzzer, pistol shooters engage pistol targets in the following order 1, 2, 1, 2, 1 (two-gun shooters repeat),

Rifle caliber rifle, engage targets in the following order 1, 2, 1, 2, 1, 2, 1, 2, 1, 2

Single-shot rifle shooters engage targets in the following order: 1 2 1 2 1 2 1 2 1 2.

Time stops.

Targets

2 pistol, 2 long range rifle, 2 pistol caliber rifle, .22 gallery target (weather permitting)
