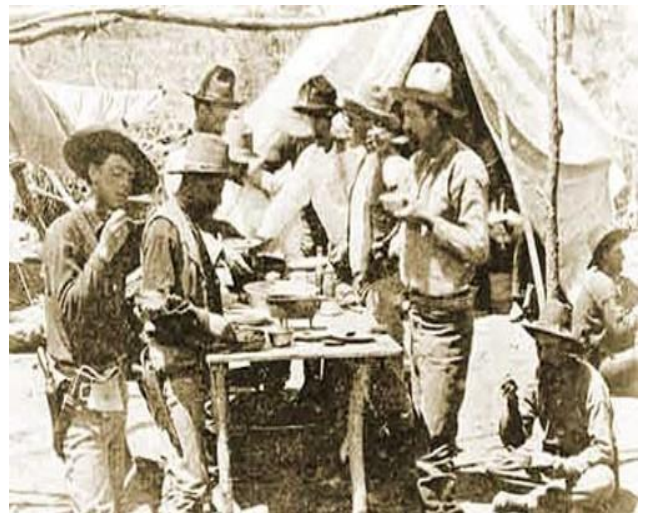

CLASSIC WESTERN MOVIE LINES

Yeah, yeah, we know! "Make my day!" didn't come from a Western. But it seems to go with the still photo from the 1903 movie - The Great Train Robbery.

There have been MANY memorable lines from MANY memorable movies, including some of our favorite Westerns.

"Frankly, my dear, I don't give a damn!" (Gone With The Wind)

"Play it, Sam." (Casablanca - Bogart did not say, "Play it again, Sam.")

"You can't handle the truth!" (A Few Good Men)

"I'll be back!" (The Terminator)

*So, make it your day and have a **great shoot!***



Stage 1 – The Virginian

***The Virginian** (from the novel by Owen Wister) was released in 1929. It starred Gary Cooper, Walter Huston, Richard Arlen, and Mary Brian.*

The Virginian is the foreman on the Box X ranch in Wyoming. His friend Steve has fallen in with a gang of rustlers led by Trampas.

At one point in the film the Virginian catches a group of rustlers who had stolen cattle from the Box X. He hangs them, including Steve. The Virginian falls for the local schoolteacher, but she is put off by his violent nature.

Early in the movie, Trampas faces off with the Virginian over the affections of a saloon girl.

Trampas says: ***“Well, who's talkin' to you?”***

The Virginian replies, ***“I'm talkin' to you, friend.”***

Trampas responds, ***“If I wanna know anything from you, I'll tell ya – you long- legged son-of-a B...”***

The Virginian draws his gun and replies...

Targets	5 pistol, 5 rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo	5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun
Props	Bar, Bartender, Ma Fricker, horse gun rack

Shooter standing with hands at sides. When ready, shooter says: ***“You wanna call me that...smile!”***

ATB, engage the 5 pistol targets 1-1-6-1-1, engaged from either direction for 10 rounds.

Engage rifle targets same as pistol.

Engage shotgun targets, no double taps.



Stage 2 – The Outlaw Josey Wales

THE OUTLAW JOSEY WALES was released in 1976 and stars Clint Eastwood, Chief Dan George, and Sondra Locke.

The film tells of a Missouri farmer whose wife and son are murdered by Union guerrillas. He joins a group of Confederate partisans and, at the war's end, refuses to surrender. As he flees pursuers, he gradually acquires a family - one he can protect.

As Josey emerges from a general store with an armload of packages, a carpetbagger recognizes him and says, **“My God, it's Josey Wales!”** A group of four Union soldiers take a sudden interest. As the tension mounts, Josey says...

Targets 5 pistol, 5 rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo 5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun
Props Wagon, package

Shooter standing behind wagon, with package in hand. When ready, shooter says: **“Well, you gonna pull those pistols or whistle 'Dixie?’”**

ATB, drop the package and engage 5 pistol targets 1-2-4-2-1, engaged from either direction for 10 rounds.

Engage rifle targets same as pistol.

Engage shotgun targets from either direction, no double taps.



Stage 3 - Unforgiven

UNFORGIVEN starring Clint Eastwood, Morgan Freeman, and Gene Hackman won the Oscar for Best Motion Picture. It was released in 1992.

Eastwood plays Bill Munny, a retired assassin, who went straight for the love of a good woman. Years later he is widowed with two children and trying to make ends meet as a pig farmer.

In the town of Big Whiskey, Wyoming, two cowboys brutally mutilate a soiled dove. Several prostitutes offer a \$1000 reward in exchange for the killing of the two men.

Munny enlists his old side kick, Ned Logan, to help.

Logan is killed and saloon owner, Skinny Dubois, props him up in a coffin in front of his saloon. Munny ain't happy!

Munny enters the saloon and kills Dubois. Sheriff Bill Daggett says, ***“Well, sir, you are a cowardly son-of-a-bitch. You just shot an unarmed man.”***

To which Munny replies...

Targets 3 pistol, 3 rifle, 4 shotgun, PP/Der
Ammo 5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun, PP/Der
Props horse gun rack, PP/Der barrel

Shooter standing at firing line. When ready, shooter says: ***“Well he should've armed himself, if he's gonna decorate his saloon with my friend!”***

ATB, engage PP/Der target. Engage shotgun targets from either end.

Engage rifle targets in a 3-2-5 sweep for 10 rounds.

Engage pistol targets same as rifle.



Stage 4 - Quigley Down Under

QUIGLEY DOWN UNDER, a "Western" set in Australia released in 1990, stars Tom Selleck, Alan Rickman, and Laura San Giacomo.

Marsden puts out an ad for a sharpshooter, and Quigley, not knowing that Marsden wants him to kill aborigines, responds to the ad.

When Quigley finds out why Marsden hired him, he takes issue, and Marsden tries to have him killed – more than once.

Eventually Quigley goes back to Marsden Station to settle things once and for all.

Quigley is captured by Marsden's men. Marsden, believing that Quigley isn't handy with a Colt, forces him into a gunfight.

With Quigley facing Marsden and two of his men, Marsden, who sees himself as quite the shootist, says, ***"Some men are born in the wrong century; I think I was born on the wrong continent."***

Quigley replies...

Targets 4 pistol, 4 rifle, 4 shotgun, PP/Der
Ammo 5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun
Props behind wagon, long guns staged on the wagon, PP/Der barrel

Shooter standing at firing line. When ready, shooter says: ***"This ain't Dodge City, and you ain't Bill Hickok!"***

ATB, engage PP/Der target. Engage rifle targets in a 2-3-3-2 sweep.

Engage shotgun targets from either direction.

Engage pistol targets same as rifle.

Stage 6 - The Outlaw Josey Wales

Late in the film, Josey is in a saloon in Santo Rio. In walks a man who says that he is looking for Josey Wales.

Josey responds, *“That'd be me.”*

The man says, *“You're wanted, Wales.”*

Josey answers, *“Reckon I'm right popular. You a bounty hunter?”*

The bounty hunter replies, *“Man's gotta do somethin' for a livin' these days.”*

Josey responds...

Targets	5 pistol, 5 rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo	5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun
Props	Bar, Bartender, Ma Fricker, horse gun rack

Shooter standing at firing line. When ready, shooter says: *“Dyin' ain't much of a livin', boy!”*

ATB, engage pistol targets 1-1-1-1-6 for 10 rounds.

Engage rifle targets the same.

Engage shotgun targets from either end, no double taps.



Stage 7 – True Grit

TRUE GRIT, starring John Wayne, Kim Darby, Glen Campbell, and Robert Duvall, was released in 1969. John Wayne won an Oscar for his performance.

Mattie Ross enlists the help of aging U. S. Marshal “Rooster” Cogburn to hunt down Tom Chaney, the murderer of her father.

Chaney has joined “Lucky Ned” Pepper's gang.

Cogburn faces Pepper and his gang across an open field.

Cogburn says, ***“I aim to kill you in one minute, Ned. Or see you hanged in Ft. Smith at Judge Parker's convenience. Which'll it be?”***

Pepper replies, ***“I call that bold talk for a one-eyed fat man.”***

Cogburn shouts...

Targets 5 pistol, 5 rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo 5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun
Props None

Shooter standing at firing line, rifle in hand. When ready, shooter says: ***“Fill your hand, you son-of-a-bitch!”***

ATB engage rifle targets 1-5-2-4-3 for 5 rounds and repeat.

Engage pistol targets same as rifle.

Engage shotgun targets from either end, no double taps.



Stage 8 - Shane

SHANE, released in 1953, and starring Alan Ladd, Jean Arthur, Van Heflin, Brandon de Wilde, and Jack Palance, is the story of a gunfighter who is tired of the life he leads and wants to change, but realizes in the end that he is what he is and, after killing a man, that he must move on.

Shane rides into a valley in Wyoming Territory and goes to work as a farmhand for homesteader Joe Starrett.

The homesteaders, although they legally own their land, are being harassed by cattleman Rufus Ryker, who sees the land as his. Ryker hires gunfighter Jack Wilson to face Shane.

In the climactic scene, Shane enters Grafton's saloon and faces Wilson.

Shane says to Wilson, ***“I've heard about you.”***

Wilson responds, ***“What have you heard, Shane?”***

Shane replies...

Targets	3 pistol, 3 rifle, 4 shotgun, PP/Der
Ammo	5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun, PP/Der
Props	horse gun rack, PP/Der barrel

Shooter standing at firing line, hands on pistol grips. When ready, shooter says: ***“I've heard that you're a low down Yankee liar!”***

Wilson (posse) says: ***“Prove it!”***

ATB engage PP/Der target. Engage shotgun targets from either end.

Engage rifle targets 1-4-5 for 10 rounds.

Engage pistol targets same as rifle.



Stage 9 - Tombstone

TOMBSTONE was released in 1993. It stars Kurt Russell, Val Kilmer, Dana Delaney, Powers Boothe, and Sam Elliott.

One of the best of the many movies that have covered the West's most famous gunfight – the street fight near the OK Corral.

After Morgan is killed, Wyatt takes Virgil, Allie, and Morgan's body to the train station in Contention. From there they travel to Tucson.

While waiting for the next train in Tucson, Wyatt spots Ike Clanton and Frank Stilwell – two of the suspects in Morgan's murder.

After Wyatt kills Stilwell, Ike pleads for his life.

Wyatt says, ***“Alright, Clanton, you called down the thunder; well now you've got it!”***

Wyatt pulls back his coat to show Ike his badge. And gives Ike a message to give to the rest of the Cowboys.

Wyatt says...

Targets 4 pistol, 4 rifle, 4 shotgun, PP/Der

Ammo 5/10 pistol, 10 rifle, 4 shotgun

Props railroad tracks, PP/Der barrel

Shooter standing at railroad tracks, empty shotgun in hand. When ready, shooter says: ***“You tell 'em I'm comin'! And hell's comin' with me! You hear? Hell's comin' with me!”***

ATB engage PP/Der target.

Engage rifle targets in a 3-2-2-3 sweep.

Engage shotgun targets from either end.

Engage pistol targets same as rifle.
