Stage 1 – The Cantina

At a cantina near Santa Poco, the German pilot inquires about El Guapo and demands respect for his friends who will arrive soon. The Amigos stop at the cantina in costume soon afterward and are assumed to be the German's friends. They mistake the fearful patrons for star-struck fans and perform a cheerful song and dance ("My Little Buttercup"). After they leave, the German's associates arrive and shoot up the cantina when the off-guard patrons mock their fine clothes.

Targets: 3 Pistol, 3 Rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Train Wall and Coal Car
Starting Position: Rifle in hand

Shooter *Sings:* *“My little buttercup, has the sweetest smile”*

ATB,

Engage rifle targets: Arkansas Shuffle (2-1-2) (*shot count*) either direction, Repeat
Engage pistol targets: same as the rifle targets.
Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.

Stage 2 – Movie Fact 1

Steve Martin learned the rope tricks he did in the movie while working at Disneyland as a teen. Martin worked there part-time from age 10 to 18, first selling guidebooks then hawking spinning lassos in Frontierland. "The ropes were hard to sell," Martin explained. "I had to wear a Western costume, cowboy shirt & hat. I did a little bit of that in the ¡Three Amigos! “

Targets: Plate Rack, 4 Pistol, 1 Rifle (dump target), 2 Shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Knockdown Door & Window
Starting Position: Hands on hat

Shooter Says: *“Wherever there is injustice, you will find us!”*

ATB Knockdown door (No kicking)
Engage pistol targets: 2-3-3-2 (*shot count*)
Move to the window
Engage rifle targets: Engage plate rack until plates are down. Remaining rounds on the dump target.
Move to second window
Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps

Stage 3 – The Village Raid

When El Guapo's men raid the village, the Amigos do a Hollywood-style stunt show that leaves the men bemused. The bandits ride off, making the villagers think they have defeated the enemy. The village throws a victory party for the Amigos.

Targets: 4 Pistol, 4 Rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Bar & Bartender
Starting Position: Hands on bar

Shooter Says: *“Tell us we will die like dogs.”*

ATB,

Engage pistol targets: Badger Sweep (1-2-3-4-1-2-3-1-2-1)(*target shot*)
Engage rifle targets: same as the pistol targets.
Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.

Stage 4 – Movie Fact 2

It was Martin Shorts first movie roll. Short had been doing sketch comedy—including on Saturday Night Live and SCTV—for years before he landed the part, but ¡Three Amigos! was his breakout film role. He went on to work with Steve Martin in two more films: Father of the Bride (1991) and Father of the Bride Part II (1995).

Targets: 5 Pistol, 5 Rifle, 2 Shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Wagon
Starting Position: Behind wagon, Hands on wagon

Shooter Says: *“You dirt-eating piece of slime! You scum-sucking pig! You sons of a motherless goat!”*

ATB,

Engage pistol targets: Double tap sweep, either direction
Engage rifle targets: same as the pistol targets.
Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.

Stage 5 – Calling out the Amigos

The following day, El Guapo and his gang come to Santa Poco and call them out, but they think it's another show. After Lucky is shot, they realize they are confronting real bandits and beg for mercy, explaining that they are harmless actors. El Guapo decides they are not worth killing, orders the village looted, and kidnaps Carmen. The Amigos leave Santa Poco in disgrace.

Targets: 5 Pistol, 5 Rifle, 3 Shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 6+ Shotgun
Props: Piano and Ugly Ma Frickert
Starting Position: Standing at the piano

Shooter Says: *"One for each other and all for one! The three great amigos are we!"*

ATB,

Engage rifle targets: Double B Sweep (1-2-3-2-1 & 5-4-3-4-5) (*target shot*)
also known as "Left and right Nevadas"

Engage pistol targets: same as the rifle targets.

Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.

Stage 6 – Movie Fact #3

Randy Newman played the singing bush. Well, technically, the Singing Bush was played by a bush, but Newman provided its voice. His voice was digitally altered for the role. In an interview with Movies.com, director John Landis explained that he'd considered several different ways of portraying the singing bush—including animating it or somehow showing its lips moving—but ultimately decided to make the bush more naturalistic and just let Newman's singing take over the scene.

Targets: 3 Pistol, 3 Rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Train Wall and Coal Car
Starting Position: Rifle in hand

Shooter Says: *"Looks like someone's been down here with the ugly stick."*

ATB,

Engage rifle targets: Brat Sweep (3-1-2-1-3), Repeat (*shot count*)

Engage pistol targets: same as the rifle targets.

Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.

Stage 7 –The Invisible Swordsman

Ned persuades Lucky and Dusty to defeat El Guapo and become real heroes. They try summoning a magical invisible swordsman to locate El Guapo, but Dusty botches the ritual and shoots the swordsman.

Targets: Plate Rack, 4 Pistol, 1 Rifle (dump target), 2 Shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Knockdown Door & Window
Starting Position: Standing at window, hands on sill

Shooter Says: *“Farley, Farley, Farley, Farley, Farley, Farley, Farley, Farley!”*

ATB,

Engage rifle targets: Engage plate rack until plates are down. Remaining rounds on the dump target..
Engage shotgun targets: Either direction, no double taps.
Engage pistol targets: Knock down door (No kicking) 2-2-2-4 (*shot count*)

Stage 8 – The Birthday Party

At his hideout, El Guapo prepares for his 40th birthday party, when he will accept a shipment of weapons from the German and then bed Carmen. The Amigos find the hideout by following the German's plane and swinging in from the outer wall with mixed results. Lucky is immediately captured and chained in a dungeon, Dusty crashes into Carmen's room, and Ned is suspended from a piñata. Lucky frees himself, but Dusty and Ned are discovered and held captive. The German, having idolized Ned's quick-draw and gun-spinning pistol skills in childhood, challenges him to a shootout. Ned kills the German, and Lucky holds El Guapo at gunpoint long enough for Carmen and the Amigos to escape in the German's plane.

Targets: 4 Pistol, 4 Rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Bar & Bartender
Starting Position: Standing next to bar

Shooter Says: *“Jefe, would you say I have a plethora of piñatas?”*

ATB

Engage pistol targets: Continuous Nevada Sweep (1-2-3-4-3-2-1-2-3-4) (*target shot*)
Engage rifle targets: same as the pistol targets.
Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.

Stage 9 – Movie Fact #4

Steven Spielberg almost directed the film. Spielberg considered making the film in the early 1980s with Martin, Robin Williams, and Bill Murray as the leads. Ultimately, he decided to make E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial (1982) instead.

Targets: 5 Pistol, 5 Rifle, 2 shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 4+ Shotgun
Props: Wagon
Starting Position: Standing behind the wagon

Shooter Says: *“Oh GREAT!!! REAL bullets!!!”*

ATB

Engage rifle targets: 2-1-4-1-2 from either direction (*shot count*)
Engage pistol targets: same as the rifle targets.
Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.

Stage 10 – The Finale

Returning to Santa Poco with El Guapo's army in pursuit, the Amigos rally the villagers to stand up for themselves with their best talent, sewing. The bandits arrive and are shot at by Amigos from all sides, forcing them to retreat as El Guapo takes a fatal wound. The villagers, all dressed as Amigos, gather around him. He compliments the Three Amigos on their cleverness, then shoots Lucky in the foot before dying. The villagers offer the Amigos all their money, but they refuse it, stating, "Our reward is that justice has been done." They then ride off into the sunset.

Targets: 5 Pistol, 5 Rifle, 3 Shotgun
Ammo: 5/10 Pistol, 10 Rifle, 6+ Shotgun
Props: Piano and Ugly Ma Frickert
Starting Position: Standing at the piano

Shooter Says: *“All of us has an El Guapo to face!”*

ATB,

Engage rifle targets: Ozark Sweep/Outside-In (1-5-2-4-3 or 5-1-4-2-3) either direction.
Repeat (*target shot*)
Engage pistol targets: same as the rifle targets.
Engage shotgun targets: either direction, no double taps.
